Lynnwood South Village: 'n Gemeenskap wat saam werk, saam beskerm en saam mooi maak

Beste inwoners

Ons wil graag met julle deel waar ons as gemeenskap staan. Die afgelope jaar het ons groot vordering gemaak met veiligheid — ons kernbesigheid. Misdaad is laag, ons reaksietye is vinnig, en ons tegnologie werk hard agter die skerms om ons dorp van rondom 300 huise veilig te hou. Dit gebeur nie vanself nie; dit gebeur omdat ons saamstaan.

Maar veiligheid is nie al wat 'n gemeenskap leefbaar maak nie. Ons het ook begin belê in die dinge wat 'n buurt mooi, ordelik en trots maak: straatbraaie, skoon sypaadjies, netjiese parke en ja — selfs die soms omstrede snoei van bome. Ons doen dit nie uit lus nie, maar uit noodsaak: om kragonderbrekings te voorkom, om infrastruktuur te beskerm, en om die dorp se karakter te bewaar.

Ons weet nie elke projek is gewild nie. Maar elke projek is deel van dieselfde groter doel: om Lynnwood South Village 'n plek te hou waar jy veilig voel, waar jou kinders kan speel, en waar jou eiendom sy waarde behou.

Ons skema kos ongeveer R1.5 miljoen per jaar om te bedryf. Bydraes is vrywillig, en tans dra sowat 63% van huishoudings by. Ons is dankbaar vir elkeen van julle wat maand na maand help dra. Sonder julle sou ons nie die resultate hê wat ons vandag sien nie.

Maar ons moet eerlik wees: veiligheid is broos. Wanneer bydraes daal, word die stelsel kwesbaar. Ons nooi elke inwoner uit om deel te wees van die oplossing — nie omdat jy moet nie, maar omdat hierdie dorp jou huis is, en omdat ons saam meer kan bereik as wat enigeen alleen kan doen.

Dankie dat julle deel is van 'n gemeenskap wat omgee, saamstaan en saam bou.

Lynnwood South Village: A Community That Works Together, Protects Together, and Grows Together

Dear residents

We would like to share an update on where we stand as a community. Over the past year, we have made significant progress in strengthening safety — our core mandate. Crime remains low, our response times are fast, and our technology works tirelessly behind the scenes to keep our village of around 300 homes secure. This does not happen by chance; it happens because we stand together.

But safety alone does not make a neighbourhood liveable. We have also invested in the things that make a community pleasant, orderly, and proud: street braais, clean pavements, well-kept parks, and yes — even the sometimes controversial trimming of trees. We do not undertake these projects for the sake of it, but out of necessity: to prevent power outages, to protect infrastructure, and to preserve the character of our village.

We know that not every project is popular. But each one forms part of the same bigger goal: keeping Lynnwood South Village a place where you feel safe, where your children can play, and where your property retains its value.

Our scheme costs approximately R1.5 million per year to operate. Contributions are voluntary, and currently about 63% of households participate. We are deeply grateful to every resident who supports the scheme month after month. Without you, the results we enjoy today would not be possible.

But we must be honest: safety is fragile. When contributions decline, the system becomes vulnerable. We invite every resident to be part of the solution — not because you are obliged to, but because this village is your home, and because together we can achieve far more than any of us can alone.

Thank you for being part of a community that cares, stands together, and builds together.
